

# Privacy statement

## 1. Personal data I process

I only process personal data of people who use my services and provide this information to me. It concerns the following data:

- First and last name
- Address data
- phone number
- E-mail address

## 2. Why do I use your personal data?

I process your personal data for the following purposes:

- Handling an order and payment
- To be able to call or e-mail you if this is necessary to carry out my services
- To be able to provide information requested by you

We also process your personal data when we are legally obliged to do so (such as information we need for the tax authorities).

## 3. How long do I retain personal data?

Your personal data will not be kept longer than is necessary to achieve the objectives mentioned in point 2.

## 4. Others with whom I share personal data

I only share your personal data with others if this is necessary for the purposes mentioned in point 2. With third parties who use your data on my order, I have concluded a processing agreement to ensure the security and confidentiality of your data. I am responsible for these processing operations by others. The following third parties have access to your personal data:

- The tax authorities (in connection with the obligation to keep invoices).
- My accounting firm.
- The administrator of the website.

## 5. Cookies and similar techniques

I only use cookies with a purely technical functionality. These cookies ensure that the website works properly and that, for example, your preferred settings are remembered. These cookies are also used to make the website work properly. We do not use cookies that keep track of your surfing behavior. You can opt out of cookies by setting your internet browser so that it does not store cookies anymore. In addition, you can also delete all information previously saved via the settings of your browser.

## 6. View, modify or delete data

- You have the right to view, correct or delete your personal data.
- You have the right to withdraw a previously given permission for data processing or to object to the processing of your personal data by us.
- You have the right to data portability. This means that you have the right to request us to send the personal information we hold to you or another organization mentioned by you.
- You can use these rights by submitting a request to [info@dolphkessler.nl](mailto:info@dolphkessler.nl) After your identity has been checked, I will respond to your request within 4 weeks.

## 7. Special and / or sensitive personal data

My website does not intend to collect data about website visitors who are younger than 16 years, unless they have permission from parents or guardians. We can not control the age of visitors. To prevent data about children being collected without your consent, we encourage parents to be involved in the online activities of their children. ## 8. How personal data are protected

The protection of your data is taken seriously. The following measures should prevent misuse, loss, unauthorized access, unwanted disclosure and unauthorized modification.

- Only the personal data that I need is saved.
- We keep documents in which personal data are stored only in digital form and on data carriers that are protected by a password.
- We work with the latest updates of software used by us.
